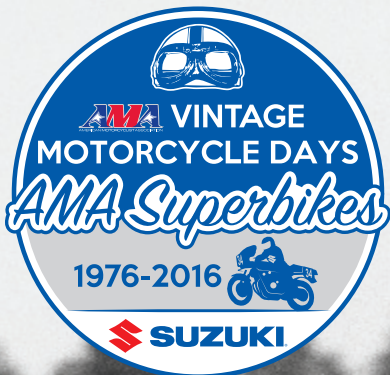

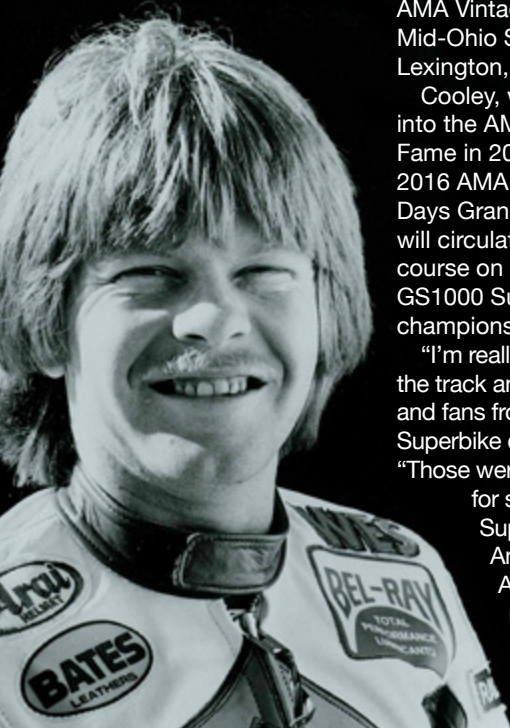

WES COOLEY: 2016 AMA VINTAGE MOTORCYCLE DAYS GRAND MARSHAL



It has been nearly 30 years since two-time AMA Superbike Champion and AMA Motorcycle Hall of Famer Wes Cooley ripped around a racetrack on a motorcycle. But it's going to happen again, July 8-10, during AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course in Lexington, Ohio.

Cooley, who was inducted into the AMA Motorcycle Hall of Fame in 2004, will serve as the 2016 AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days Grand Marshal. Cooley will circulate the Mid-Ohio race course on the same Suzuki GS1000 Superbike he rode to his championship in 1980.

"I'm really excited to get back to the track and meet a lot of friends and fans from those exciting Superbike days," Cooley says. "Those were some crazy years, for sure—for me and for Superbike racing in general. And since 2016 is the 40th Anniversary of Superbike racing, I really can't think of a better reunion than to go back to

Mid-Ohio as AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days Grand Marshal and celebrate how exciting and popular Superbikes have been all these years.

“I also can’t wait to ride one of my Superbikes at the event,” Cooley adds. “Superbike collector Brian O’Shea owns my 1980 Yoshimura racer, and I’m itching to climb back aboard the thing at Mid-Ohio.”

O’Shea is one of the country’s foremost Superbike collectors. His stable includes a range of historically significant championship-winning race bikes. O’Shea is bringing several of the bikes from his personal collection to AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days for fans to see and enjoy.

“I’ve been building and collecting championship-winning Superbikes for a number of years,” O’Shea says. “Aside from the Cooley racer, I’m planning to bring Freddie Spencer’s 1985 Honda VF750F Daytona

200 winner, Reg Pridmore’s 1978 championship-winning KZ1000 and a Bubba Shobert VFR750F. With the Cooley GS, we’ll have an amazing range of classic, pedigreed, championship-winning Superbikes on display at AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days this summer. It’s going to be really exciting!”

It’s all coming together to create a rare spectacle for fans of AMA Superbike racing. AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days, Celebrating 40 Years of AMA Superbikes, will allow fans to get up close and personal with these historic motorcycles. As grand marshal, Cooley will be on hand throughout the weekend to sign autographs, participate in Q&A sessions and perform demonstration laps on the GS1000 each day.

As is always the case, attendees can also expect to run into other AMA Motorcycle Hall of Famers enjoying the sights and sounds of AMA Vintage Motorcycle Days.

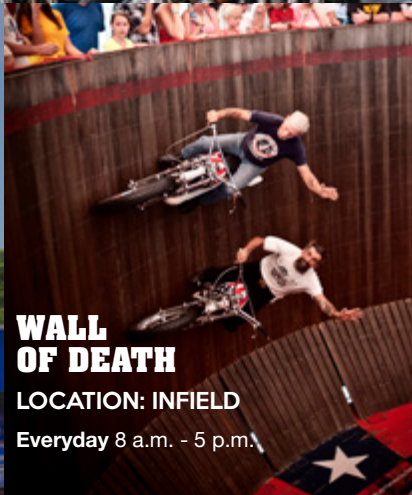

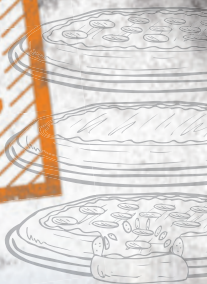
